

City of Kingfisher Collection Center

The City of Kingfisher Collection Center is available for residential household solid waste only, for occasional excess waste or large items that cannot fit in the polycart. It is not a substitute for curbside collection services.

Customers accessing the site must bring their current KPWA Utility Bill, along with photo identification, to validate eligibility for site access. The service is only available for City/KPWA customers with residential solid waste (garbage) services.

Initial operations will have 4 containers for solid waste, 1 container for metals, 2 containers for mixed recyclables. Access for green waste (brush, limbs, tree trunks and shrubs) remains unchanged. Green waste products must be cut to 48" in length or smaller.

- No loose trash, bagged or sealed boxes only.
- No loaded trailers, proceed directly to a landfill.
- Not for commercial uses; construction/remodel debris nor rental property cleanout. Customers with these needs should contact city hall for container recommendations.
- All solid waste must be placed in the container by the customer.
- Appliances must have doors removed
- **Prohibited items:** Tires, Batteries, Shingles, Paints, Appliances with Freon, liquids, radioactive, volatile, explosive, toxic or highly flammable materials.



The Collection Center is located on the east side of US 81/Main St, across from Airport Road. It is the first east turn after crossing the bridge over Kingfisher Creek. Please use caution when exiting.

Due to bridge construction, exiting traffic may only turn north (right) until construction is complete.

All guest must check in with City staff upon entry, to present photo Identification and a copy of current City of Kingfisher/KPWA Utility Bill.
